WINTER WEATHER IS HERE!

The weather is changing quickly! Students are reminded to dress according to the weather and to assume that they will be outdoors at recesses, unless the temperature becomes unreasonable.

INCLEMENT WEATHER

If the weather is stormy prior to the start of the school day, please listen to the radio. Every attempt will be made to announce class cancellations on the various radio stations by 7:00 a.m. This information can also be found on <u>www.businfo.ca</u> (Sudbury Student Services Consortium website). If classes are cancelled, please do not bring your child to school.

If schools are open but buses are cancelled and you drop your child off, please remember that it cannot be sooner than 8:35 a.m. as we do not have supervision until then. Also, remember that your child must be picked up by the end of the school day. (3:10 p.m.)

If you choose not to send your child to school on a day when buses are cancelled, please call the school (705) 675-5961 to notify us of your child's absence.

The following discretionary guidelines are followed:

- 15 20° below We normally go out for all recesses
- 20 25° below We go out for recess or a shortened recess
- 25 30° below with wind chill factor Indoor recesses

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LET'S KEEP OUR CHILDREN SAFE

Please note that the bus loading zone in front of the school is a no stopping/no parking area. This includes the opposite side of the street on St. Brendan as well. Parking is available along St. Nicholas, Homewood and neighbouring streets.

HEAD LICE

Parents are asked to be vigilant and to check their child(ren) at least 3 to 4 times a week. Lice like clean hair. With sporting events occurring and travelling especially over the holidays it is easy to get lice.

If you detect lice on your child, please contact the school. A letter will be sent home to all students in the classroom where lice are detected, including the reading buddies classroom. Please keep your child home until they are nit free.

By working together, we are better able to control lice.

STUDENTS MAKING AFTER SCHOOL ARRANGEMENTS

All after school arrangements with classmates need to be made the evening before not during class hours. Please provide a note to the classroom teacher explaining the new after school arrangements.

Students will not be able to leave school property with the new arrangements they've made unless they have a note from their parents or guardians. Students will not be allowed to leave the classroom to call parents to seek permission for after school plans. This will ensure the safety and the whereabouts of all of our students.

Please be aware that your child cannot get on a bus other than their own to go home with a friend. Bus drivers are only permitted to carry their regular passengers.

MORNING ARRIVAL AND DISMISSAL

Arrival

Please be aware there is no supervision at the school until 8:35 AM. Children should not be in the playground prior to that time. Parents are asked to register for daycare if they need to bring their child to school before 8:35 AM.

Walkers

At the school bell all walkers must leave school property. There is no supervision for walkers. The supervisors on duty are focusing on the bussing students. If your child misses their bus, you will be contacted. Parents are encouraged to remind their child that it is important not to wander around the school and to promptly join their bus line in the gymnasium.

End of Day Pick up

All students who get picked up at the end of the day must be picked up at the set of green doors closest to the kindergarten rooms. A supervisor on duty will hand your child off to you as they see you. This might take a few extra minutes but ensuring student safety is our primary concern. All students not picked up by 3:16 PM will be brought up to the office.

PARENT VOLUNTEERS ON CLASS EXCURSIONS

In order to maintain this, siblings/other children are asked NOT to be included on the class trip, as parent volunteers need to focus on the children in their group. Bringing other siblings or children could interfere with the safety of the other children. In order to be a parent volunteer, you must have a recent criminal record check.
