### **PUFFERS EPI PENS AND MEDS**

For the Safety of all children in the school, it is required that parents inform the school if their child has an allergy or suffers from asthma.

If your child needs to take medication, please contact the school to receive the appropriate forms that give the school authorization to administer medication to your child. Please note, some forms will require a signature from your Primary Care Provider.

When sending your child to school with any over the counter medication, please contact the school to receive the proper forms that must be completed prior to sending the medication to school. A note from home authorizing its use is not sufficient. Our RDSB forms allow parents to provide the school with detailed information indicating the dose and time the child needs to take the medication. RDSB Forms are mandatory.

If your child has any life threatening allergies, asthma, diabetes or epilepsy, it is important to meet with the principal to create a **Plan of Care** to ensure the safety of your child.

Working together will help us ensure the safety of all children in the school.

### STUDENT ABSENCES

### **VISITORS**

Parents with students with anaphylactic reactions please make sure you notify the classroom teacher and set up an appointment to meet with the principal to arrange a Plan of Care.

### ASTHMA- FRIENDLY SCHOOLS Many children have asthma.

Please contact your school Principal as soon as possible, if you are a parent/guardian of a child with asthma. We need your cooperation in providing the school with current medical information and in developing a plan with your child's Principal.

Students under 16 years of age who have parental permission are permitted to carry their own asthma medication with them at school.

Students 16 years of age and older do not require parental permission.

Please be advised that in-school piano lessons are temporarily on-hold. You may contact Joanne Leblanc at (705) 929-7422 to discuss the interim option of in-home lessons and the safety measures discussed with the Health Unit. Thank you for your patience

K to 8 students should bring: an extra mask in a container/envelope, paper bag, a **labelled** water bottle, a washable placemat in their lunch bag and indoor shoes. Please remember: Masks and containers **MUST** be labelled. **All** students in grades 1-8 are required to wear masks .Kindergarten students are required to wear a mask or a shield .

If sending hand sanitizer it must be unscented.

Students may bring an outdoor activity such as a frisbee or skipping rope for recess time but it must stay in the backpack.

Recycling items must go back home with the student as there will be no recycling offered at this time.

### PICKING UP AND DROPPING OF YOUR CHILD DROP OFF PROCEDURES:

When dropping off your child to school after the school day has started, please note the new changes.

Parent(s)/ Guardian(s) will not enter the main building of the school. After buzzing at the entrance, the school will unlock doors to allow access to the school from the main entrance which leads to the atrium. Once you sign in your child at the entrance, you will leave the school as your child proceeds (independently) to the main part of the building. We have a camera installed in the atrium and are able to monitor your child as they come up the stairs.

### **PICK UP PROCEDURES:**

When picking up your child before the end of the school day, please call the office in advance so that we can have your child ready for you. Once arrived at the school, you will buzz the office from the main entrance and be granted access to the Atrium. Do not enter the main part of the building. You will sign out your child on a clipboard in the atrium.

### STUDENT COHORTS (classes)

Students will spend each school day with their classmates and classroom educators in their designated classroom or outside in the schoolyard. All subjects will be taught in their home rooms. Please visit the RDSB's Reopening Guide for more information.

Drinking fountains have been covered and use of them will not be permitted. Water filling stations are still available for use. Students are required to bring their own water bottle to school each day. Please ensure your child's water bottle has their name on it.

### **DAILY SCREENING FOR SYMPTOMS**

Safety is a shared responsibility between the school, the home and the community, and families play a critical role in limiting the spread of COVID-19.

Parents/guardians will be required to screen their children daily for any COVID-19 symptoms using the Pre-screening Questionnaire and keep them home from school if they or anyone in the household are sick or have had close contact with anyone diagnosed with COVID-19. Families, including children, are required to self-isolate for 14 days if there has been travel outside of Canada. Parents/guardians can support their children's education by encouraging them to follow health and safety protocols at school, at home, on the bus, and in the community. This includes keeping a safe distance, washing or sanitizing hands, coughing or sneezing into an elbow, and wearing a mask, as required. Students, teachers and school staff must self-screen for symptoms of COVID-19 before leaving home. Do not send any paper copy of the pre-screening questionnaire to the school. Students and staff who are unwell must stay home from school, should seek testing and appropriate medical attention, and remain at home while waiting for test results.

\* If a student has a pre-existing medical condition, parents are advised to talk to the family's health provider before returning to school.
